SUBJECT: Proposed Flint FY 2008-2009 Tuition & Fees Rates

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of 2008-2009 Tuition & Fees Rates


BACKGROUND:

The proposed FY 2008-2009 Tuition and Fee rates assume a 2.0% increase in State funding. These rates include a 5.9% increase in combined tuition and fees for resident undergraduate students (and 4.9% for graduates) from the rates approved by the Regents for FY 2007-2008.

The FY 2008-2009 General Fund budget, in the companion Action Item, increases student financial aid 7.9%, 2.0% above the proposed increase in combined tuition and fees.

We request approval of the proposed FY 2008-2009 combined tuition and fee rates.

Footnotes

(1) The percentage increase for tuition and fees combined is 5.9% for undergraduates and 4.9% for graduates.

(2) In order to be competitive in the market, MBA rates are unchanged from the 2007-2008 fiscal year.

(3) The reported rate for NetPlus represents a rate per term. This is a two-year program with four terms per year.

(4) The increase in the technology fee is necessary to keep up with the costs of providing students with state of the art technology.

(5) The increase in the Student Activity Fee is necessary due to the increased emphasis on campus life as student housing opens in the Fall.
