Proposed Flint FY 2009-2010 Tuition & Fees Rates

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of 2009-2010 Tuition & Fees Rates

BACKGROUND:

The proposed FY 2009-2010 Tuition and Fee rates assume a 1% decrease in state funding. These rates include a 6.5% increase in combined tuition and fees for resident undergraduate students (and 4.9% for graduates) from the rates approved by the Regents for FY 2008-2009.

The FY 2009-2010 General Fund budget, in the companion Action Item, increases student financial aid 8.5%, 2% above the proposed increase in combined tuition and fees.

We request approval of the proposed FY 2009-2010 combined tuition and fee rates.

Footnotes

- (1) The percentage increase for tuition and fees combined is 6.5% for undergraduates and 4.9% for graduates.
- (2) The tuition differential for generic Nursing has increased to 17% above the undergraduate upper division rate for FY10. The differential in FY09 was 12.65%.
- (3) The reported rate for NetPlus represents a rate per term. This is a two-year program with four terms per year.
- (4) The non-resident rates for Graduate Physical Therapy (DPT) and Anesthesia (MS) have increased significantly due to a change in the rate structure. The rates are now equal to the standard non-resident Graduate rate (based on 12 credit hours).
- (5) Non-resident Anesthesia students completing the second of their two-year program will continue to pay the resident rate in FY10. The new rate structure applies only to students admitted to the program in FY10.
