ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of 2005-06 General Fund Budget

BACKGROUND:

The proposed 2005-06 General Fund Budget reflects a 2.1% reduction in the appropriation from the State of Michigan as recommended by the Governor. The recommended tuition and fee increase for undergraduate and graduate students is 11.9%. Further details on tuition and fee increases are included in the companion Action Item.

Our proposed budget includes a modest salary program and funding for significant increases in health care benefit costs and utilities. It provides resources for new faculty lines needed to assure continued accreditation of our School of Management. Student financial aid increases are slightly more than twice the percentage increase in tuition and fees. The budget continues phasing in support for the Fairlane Center that will be needed when the Ford lease expires.

Additional details of the 2005-06 budget are outlined in the attached tables.

We recommend the Regents approve the proposed 2005-06 General Fund Budget.
