ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of 2006-07 General Fund Budget

BACKGROUND:

The proposed 2006-07 General Fund Budget reflects a 2.9% increase in the appropriation from the State of Michigan. The recommended tuition and fee increase for undergraduate and graduate students is 8%. Further details on tuition and fee increases are included in the companion Action Item.

Our proposed budget includes a 3% salary program and funding for significant increases in financial aid (12.9%) and utilities (14.9%). It provides resources for new faculty lines needed to assure continued accreditation of our School of Management. The budget continues phasing in support for the Fairlane Center that will be needed when the Ford lease expires. Also included is the final installment of operating fund requirements for the soon to be completed Science and Engineering building additions.

Additional details of the 2006-07 budget are outlined in the attached tables.

We recommend the Regents approve the proposed 2006-07 General Fund Budget.
