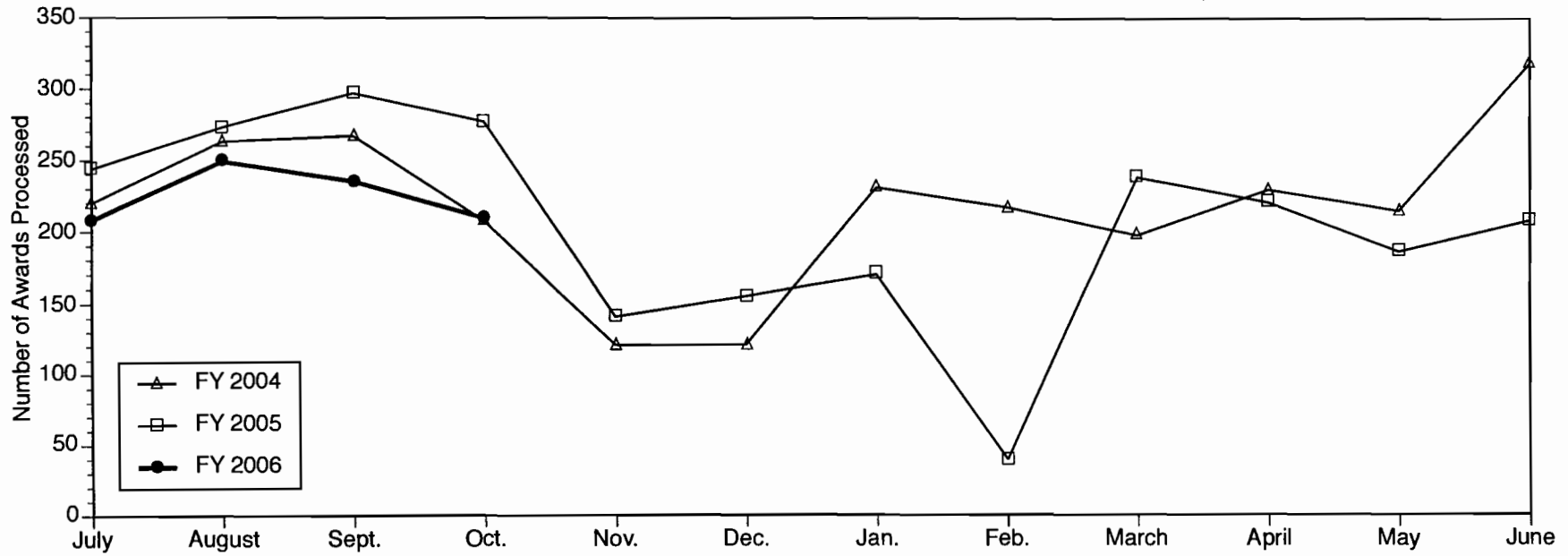
The awards detailed in this list were processed from October 1, 2005 through October 31, 2005. The dollar values depict the best available estimate of the funding the University should receive over the life of the award. These values may be modified, as additional data become available relative to future funding prospects. These modifications are not reported in the attached list. As a result, the dollar values of awards presented in this list will differ from the year-end totals. The full amount of an award is recorded in the year in which it was received. Often these funds are expended over several years, making comparisons between awards and expenditures somewhat misleading. Research expenditures are presented here to provide a trend line for the current fiscal year.

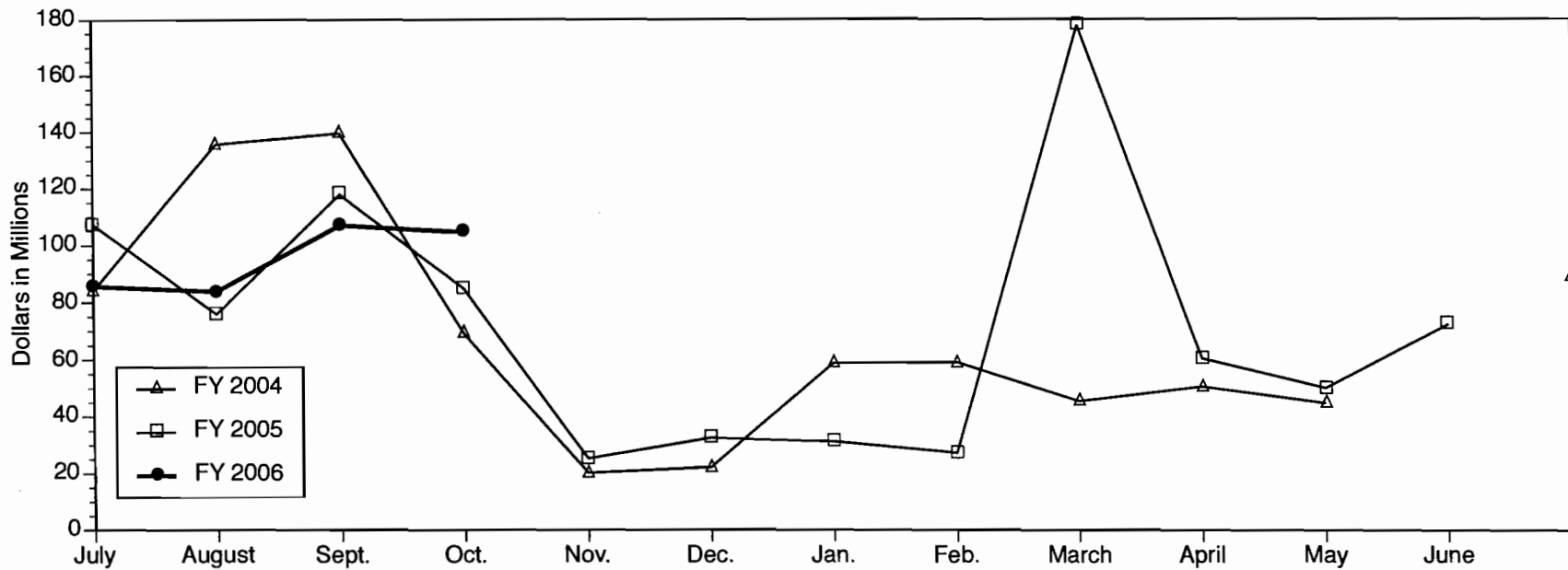
October 2005 was a strong month for awards processed when compared with October 2004. Two large awards, one for \$25.0 million from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to the Transportation Research Institute, and a second award for \$18.7 million was awarded by the National Institutes of Health to the Michigan Life Sciences Corridor were processed. Added to the two large awards processed last month totaling \$31.6 million, a total of four awards with a combined total of \$75.3 million have been processed in September and October.
