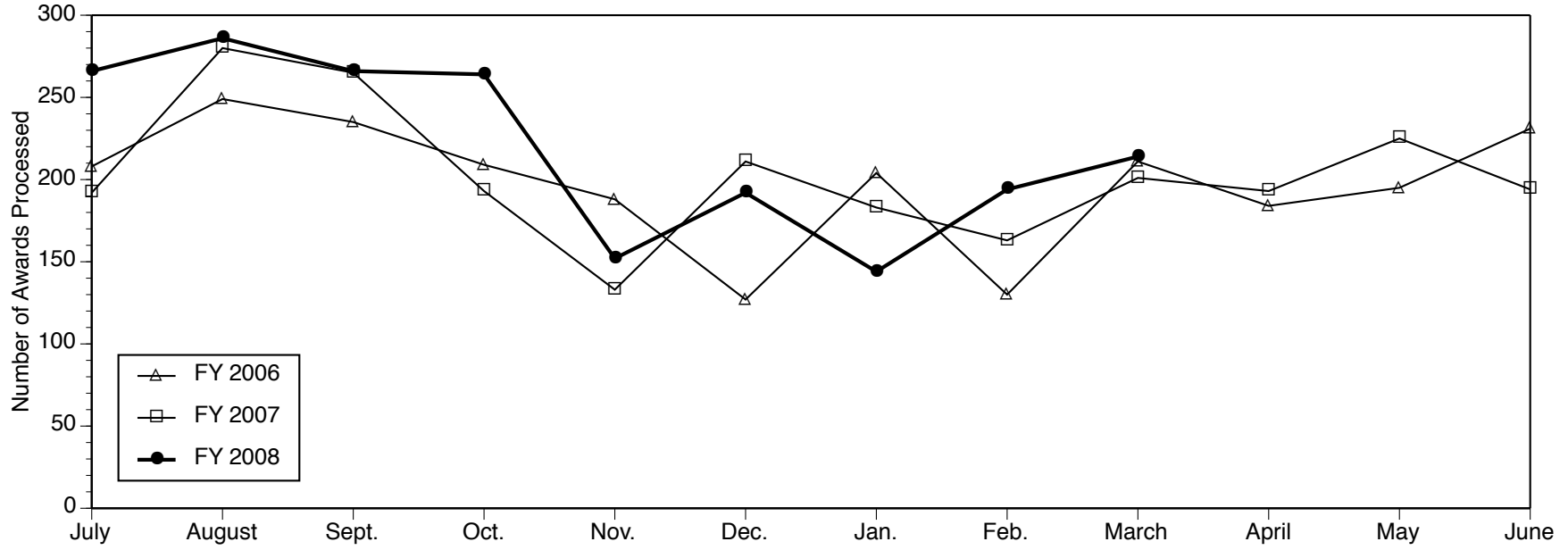
March 2008 award activity continues the robust trend evident for most of FY 2008. The March 2008 13.9% increase over March 2007 activity is caused not only by the larger number of awards but also by an increase in the number of awards valued in excess of \$1.0 million. There were 26 such awards totaling \$62.0 million in March 2008 compared with 21 such awards in March 2007 totaling \$51.9 million.

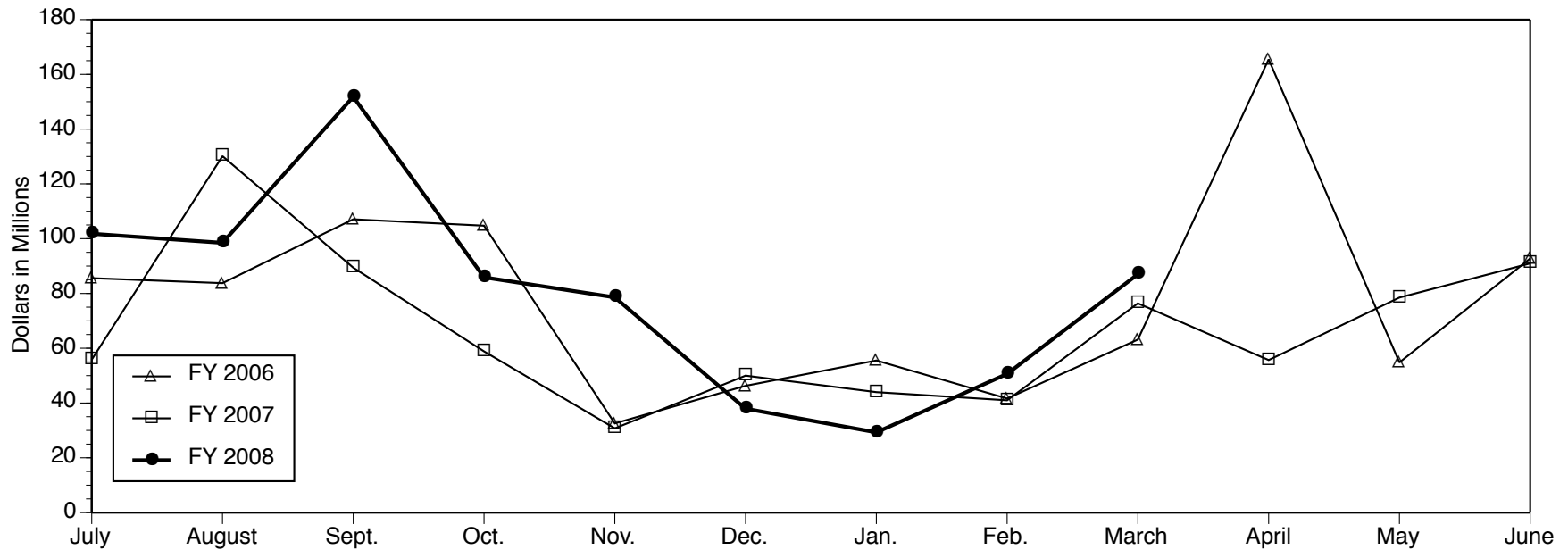
