
Background:

Michigan Stadium was constructed in 1924 as a cast-in-place concrete structure. In the normal weathering process, the concrete deteriorates over time, and periodic maintenance is needed to maintain the structural integrity of the stadium. The 2007 concrete repairs project is the final phase to complete the concrete replacement in the stadium with construction occurring in the northeast corner (Sections 34-39), and will include the removal and replacement of concrete and replacement of seats in those sections.

The estimated cost of the project is \$2,500,000. Funding will be provided from Athletic Department resources. The construction cash flow may be provided, all or in part, by increasing the commercial paper issuance under the commercial paper program, secured by a pledge of General Revenues, and authorized by the Regents. The University of Michigan Department of Architecture, Engineering and Construction will design the project. Construction is scheduled to be completed in August 2007.

We recommend that the Regents approve the Michigan Stadium 2007 Concrete Repairs project as described, and authorize issuing the project for bids and awarding construction contracts providing that bids are within the approved budget.
